APPLICATION GUIDE

USES

Tear Mender is a non-toxic adhesive that forms permanent, yet flexible bonds to porous materials. It can be used on both indoor and outdoor fabrics and is ideally suited for repairs on clothing, leather, upholstery, home decor, sport/marine gear and more.

GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

Shake well before use. Spread a thin layer of Tear Mender onto a patch or the item being repaired. For thicker material, apply to both the patch and the surface being repaired. Press the two surfaces together and allow to dry for 3 minutes. Tear Mender is wearable in 3 minutes and machine washable in 15 minutes.

Spot test when used on sheer or light fabrics.

Best if used within 12 months of purchase. DO NOT expose to freezing temperatures

NON-TOXIC and ECO-FRIENDLY

Tear Mender is formulated with natural latex and has minimal impact to the environment.

Tear Mender works by filling the tiny gaps in the fabric weave and drying to form a flexible and wash-proof bond



In just a few simple steps these torn jeans can be **easily** and **permanently** repaired using Tear Mender.



Add a small amount of Tear Mender to the repair patch. It is safe to use your finger to spread the glue around the fabric.



Adhere the patch to the underside of the tear by pressing evenly and firmly on the bonded area. Let dry for 3 minutes.



You now have a permanent, washable and functional repair.

The Story Of "THE BISH"
